Accepting donations for:

- Perennials, bulbs, seedlings, native plants
- House plants
- Garden-related items such as tools, garden decor, plant supports etc.

Prepare your plants:

- **Plants should be potted**
 - Using old garden-centre pots, or try recyclable food containers such as berry baskets or yogurt containers
 - Large plants can be placed in cardboard boxes or plastic bags
- **Plants should be labelled**
 - Using water-proof labels or permanent marker on masking tape
- **Divide ahead of time**
 - Perennials will look their best if they are divided early (instead of the day before)

Please be aware of invasive plant species:

We will not be reselling species that are listed on the Ontario Invasive Plant Council website. This includes:

- Vinca (Periwinkle), goutweed, english ivy, yellow flag iris, lily of the valley, invasive honeysuckles and ditch lily.
