-Monies for insurance and park insurance and maintenance costs at the park have been paid.

-Because of covid OHA arranged with OMAFRA that societies would receive the yearly grant based on membership in 2019. Thus we received a grant of \$1500.00. We had over 200 members in 2019.

-Heather Ashe organized 2 virtual plant sales and we made over \$900.00.

-We purchased anniversary books and about half of them have been sold. Some complimentary copies were given out. The books are available for sale for \$10.00.
