Hints and Rules for Show:

1. (a) **Use Ontario Judging and Exhibiting Standards** for Horticultural and Floral Design
(b) **Check instructions carefully.**
Some entries have a specific number of stems, spikes, blooms, etc.
2. A bud showing colour will be counted as a bloom.
3. Gladioli must not exceed 24" from lowest floret.
4. Use clear glass bottles or jars except in arrangements and bud vases for roses.
5. Your exhibits must be from your own garden. **Design categories**, however, can be from any source. Exceptions made for children.
6. Entries will be recognized as follows:
 - (a) Exhibits in Classes A, B, will receive recognition in the amount of \$4, \$3, \$2 for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place respectively and \$1 for honourable mention.
 - (b) Exhibits in Class C will receive recognition in the amount of \$5, \$3, \$2 for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in each design.
 - (c) Best in Show will receive a ribbon (both Senior and Junior Divisions).
 - (d) First Time Exhibitor will receive an award of \$5.
 - (e) No award will be made to unworthy exhibits even though they may be the only entry.
7. All children are encouraged to enter the Show. Membership not necessary.
8. **ONE ENTRY PER PERSON PER CATEGORY.**
9. Exhibits must be disease free, clean, and healthy.
Remove dead buds and leaves, damaged flowers or petals, for a clean look.
10. Improperly classified entries will be disqualified.
