Help us to plant flowers downtown and around town.

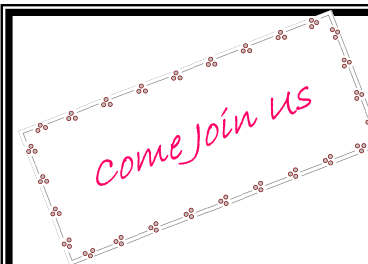
