SPECIAL PROJECT GRANT

To assist the societies within District 4 in meeting the objectives of the Ontario Horticultural Association, the Board will provide a **SPECIAL PROJECT GRANT** for up to three projects or enhance an existing project, per year to a maximum of \$200.00 for each project A society that receives a Special Project Grant cannot apply again for this grant for two calendar years. Project is to be completed by **September 30**.

CRITERIA

Society

Projects must be of a long-lasting benefit to the society or community. The judging panel will be looking for a budget, and a site plan showing the placement and quantity of each plant variety. Extra consideration will be given for the use of native plants, society and community involvement.

This grant <u>may</u> be used for the purchase of perennial plants, trees and shrubs. The grant is <u>not</u> to be used for annuals, mulch, manure, compost, hard surface, rain barrels, signage or construction materials.
