2023 OMAFRA ANNUAL RETURN

These are both due by February 1st but if **you can complete in the near future or in early January** – then there is no panic at the end of the month if you have issues with the form etc. Please.... Do not leave until the last week of January. (only those Societies that have a December year end can do that but they can complete almost all the information prior to the AGM)
