Entries deadline- the members are responsible for placing each entry in the correct class before the start of the meeting between 8:30-9:30am.

Rules and Regulations for Flower Show

- -Entries are welcome from all members. There is no entry fee.
- -All entries for competition must be grown in exhibitor's own garden or home except in design classes. Fresh plant material for these designs may be obtained from any source. Any artificial flowers/foliage and invasive/poisonous plants are not permitted and will be disqualified.
- -In design classes, a neatly printed card giving a brief explanation of the interpretive design is permitted.
- -Any potted plant must be grown and cared for by the exhibitor for at least 2 months.
- **-Exhibitors may enter only one item in each class number**. Entries that are not in accordance with show schedule class specifics will be disqualified.
- -Exhibitors must furnish their own containers and remove all entries after the show. Entries not removed by the exhibitor, or their designate, will become the property of the Horticultural Society. Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage to containers.
- -Entry tags will be provided by the Society upon signing in on the day of the show.
- -Judging will be based on the Ontario Judging and Exhibiting Standards for Horticulture and Floral Design Standards Publication# 34, 2003.
- -The decision of the judges shall be final in all cases.
- -Show committee may sub-divide and /or add classes in any division, as warranted.
- -Each entry to be shown with its own foliage unless otherwise stated. Buds showing colour are counted as blooms.
- -Ribbons will be given to the 1st, 2nd and 3^{rd place} winners.
