

CLIMATE CHANGE AND HOW IT AFFECTS OUR GARDENS

April's meeting welcomed our guest speaker Gordon Miller. Gordon is an ecologist and environmental policy analyst with many years of experience. While Gordon is well accredited, most of his career has been spent in the public sector starting as a scientist with the Ministry of the Environment and concluding his career by serving three five-year terms as Ontario's Environmental Commissioner.

Gordon's presentation explained the impact of Green House Gases on the environment. He explained that large amount of GHG are being added to the atmosphere and unfortunately it is too late to stop it. The warmer atmosphere holds more water vapour so when it condenses we get heavier precipitation. He talked about there being two significant sources of human origin to the Greenhouse Effect, fossil fuel burning and land use change.

He illustrated that climate change will impact us as gardeners in Almaguin/Muskoka due to:

Generally wetter weather, although drought in the summer Warmer in spring and fall
More very hot days and topical nights
Few extremely cold winter days
Longer frost-free periods
Increased rainfall will likely come in heavy events, which can produce soil compaction and gullying.

The solution to drought, compaction and erosion is Organic Matter content in your soil.
