- Essay: 30% of total score
- Level of horticultural activity/experience 30%

Essays will be judged by a panel comprised of 3 members of the Woolwich Gardeners (Elmira & District Horticultural Society) Board of Directors and will be scored based on the following criteria:

- Clarity of thought
- Creativity/originality
- Potential positive impact
- Grammar and spelling
