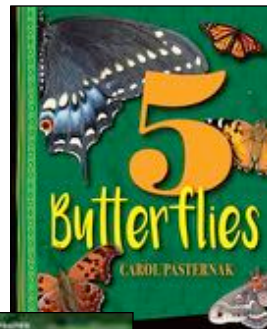

### **Thursday, July 11: 4pm and 7pm Pam Heise's Garden, 22 Corners Avenue, Port Bolster**

Backing onto privately-owned conservation-protected land, these gardens are transitioning from a once shady park-like setting to full sun, due to the loss of many full-size ash trees. Now everything is adapting to the new normal as new plant growth takes root. Come and see the changes. Parking: along Corners Avenue and side streets.

### **Thursday, July 18: 4pm and 7pm Deb Banfield's Garden, 347 Hedge Road, Sutton**

A mix of old and new...hidden behind the hedges along Lake Simcoe. An old arbour, 30-year perennial bed, a large vegetable patch and lots of colourful points of interest. Please come and visit. Parking: both sides of Pefferlaw Road. Note: Construction road closure at Zephyr River; when coming from the east (from Durham 23), turn right onto Griffiths Avenue, then left onto Main Street. At the stop sign, turn left onto Pefferlaw Road. Ruth's house is on the left.
