
# WHERE?


# WHAT Does Oshawa Have To Offer?



## Parkwood National Historic Site

Built in 1917 it was the stately home of Sam McLaughlin and his family until 1972. “Col. Sam” was the founder of the McLaughlin Motor Car Company which eventually became General Motors.

The Estate is now open for tours and is a favourite location for many movies and television shows to film.





## **The Robert McLaughlin Gallery-**

This gallery is known for its works by the first abstract artists collective Painters Eleven. It is named for the founder of the McLaughlin Carriage Company which eventually became General Motors.

## **Canadian Tank Museum-**

Over 140 operational historic military vehicles are contained within this accredited Canadian Armed Forces Museum. Two hundred plus volunteers run the museum and maintain the vehicles which span the period between WWI and the Afghanistan conflict. Many of the vehicles regularly take part in the Oshawa Remembrance Day parade.

## **Canadian Automotive Museum-**

The museum details the history of Canada's automotive industry and includes such delights as Disney's Lightning McQueen and a 1983 Dorlean as made famous by the film series Back to the Future.
