Ontario Horticultural Association Tree Grants

Starting January 1 each year, the OHA distributes grants for up to \$200 for the purchase, delivery, planting and installation of a tree or trees by a horticultural society on public land. Grants are given to the first 20 eligible horticultural societies who request a tree grant before February 28th. To be eligible, the society must be in good standing with the OHA, not have received a tree grant in the last 3 full years and must include a letter of permission by the municipality/city indicating that the society may plant the tree at the intended location. To apply, simply fill out the form below and send to the OHA Awards Coordinator:
